

## Appearance

*If a student's uniform or appearance does not match our expectations they will have to correct it before being allowed into lessons.*

*Non-uniform items will be confiscated until 30 minutes after the end of the school day.*

- Greenshaw sweatshirt with school name and coloured logo.
- Black polo shirt with coloured logo.
- Pleated black skirt from our supplier.
- No additional clothing visible under the uniform (eg long sleeved top under the polo shirt).
- No alternative clothing instead of the sweatshirt (eg cardigan/jacket/sweatshirt).
- Headscarves should be plain black or white and should not obscure the Greenshaw logo on the sweatshirt.
- Plain black trousers from our supplier.
- Natural or plain black tights, or plain white or black ankle socks. No patterned tights, knee length socks or leggings.
- Smart flat plain black leather shoes, sensible for school. (\*1)
- Coats should be plain and smart in appearance. No hoodies, leather jackets, denim jackets, those with studs or big slogans or logos.
- Greenshaw bag with all the necessary equipment.
- Obvious make-up is not allowed, including nail varnish or artificial nails.
- Hairstyles should be moderate and appropriate for school. (\*2)
- Items of jewellery are not allowed except a standard wristwatch and one pair of small studs worn in the ear lobe only. No other piercings are allowed. (\*3)
- All electronic equipment, including mobile phones, smart watches and headphones, should not be visible, heard or used at any time on the school site unless instructed by a teacher. (\*4)
- If a student has electronic equipment, including headphones, a smart watch or a mobile phone, visible on the school site, they will be confiscated and returned 30 mins after school, unless warned otherwise.



\*1 If a student wears incorrect shoes they will be expected to wear Greenshaw plimsolls.

\*2 Hair should be of a natural colour.

\*3 If a student has any other piercings, they will not be allowed to cover it with a plaster or wear any form of bar or stud, clear or otherwise at school. The school accepts no responsibility for any financial issues or risk of infection that arises if students are asked to remove piercings.

\*4 If a student has electronic equipment, including headphones, a smart watch or a mobile phone, visible on the school site, they will be confiscated and a sanction applied.
