EXAM CONTINGENCY DATES

Please be aware that The Joint Council for Qualification (JCQ) has introduced contingency dates for all exam boards in the UK. In line with Ofqual's exam system contingency plan these sessions are specifically set aside, should sustained national or local disruption arise during the Summer 2026 examination series. If disruption happens, the GCSE and/or A level examinations would be taken either for the first time or again on these sessions, in which case it is possible that timetable dates could be affected up to and including the last contingency day. The contingency date for 2026 is 24 June 2026. Therefore we would advise not to be at any distance from school before 25 June 2026.
