

# My Child - Assignments

If we select **Assignments**, this displays all assignments assigned to the child (Abigail Sanders in this example) for the current week, on their due date.

By default, the option All Subjects is selected, but you can filter assignment data on a per subject basis if required as well as scrolling to view previous weeks assignments or into the future to see upcoming assignments.

In this example, we are viewing all assignments (All Subjects) for week commencing 22/06/2020 and can see that the following assignments have been issued to Abigail Sanders:

- Colour Wheel – Art and Design
- Algorithms and Flow Charts – ICT
- Fix My Code – ICT
