

SELECTIVE ELIGIBILITY TEST FOR SEPTEMBER 2021

GREENSHAW HIGH SCHOOL CANDIDATES

IMPORTANT GUIDANCE ON WHAT YOU SHOULD DO IF YOU THINK YOUR CHILD IS NOT FIT, WHETHER FOR MEDICAL OR OTHER REASONS, TO SIT THE SELECTIVE ELIGIBILITY TEST ON WEDNESDAY 11 NOVEMBER 2020

When a child says they are not feeling well, it is sometimes difficult for a parent to decide what to do. Are they just anxious or really sick?

It is important that your child is given the opportunity to do their very best in the Selective Eligibility Tests which is not possible if they are not 'fit' to sit the test. Not being fit means that your child's condition or well-being on the day of the test, other than suffering from normal and expected levels of nerves, is such that their performance during the test may be impaired.

If you believe your child is not fit to take the test on Wednesday 11 November, you must notify Greenshaw High School by 12pm on 11 November 2020 by calling **0208 715 1001**.

DO NOT BRING THEM TO THE TEST.

You must produce a doctor's certificate verifying your child's illness on 11 November 2020. The doctor's certificate should be provided to Greenshaw High School no later than Monday 16 November. If you do not provide a doctor's certificate your child will not be invited to sit the test at a later date.

Do not bring your child to the test if they are showing any symptoms of COVID or are self-isolating because of recent contact with someone showing symptoms. Evidence may be requested. Please notify Greenshaw High School as above.

In addition, if your child has experienced a sudden recent traumatic incident, for example a bereavement, you may consider that he/she is not in a fit state to do the test. Please contact the school as above and explain the circumstances. Evidence may be requested.
