SELECTIVE ELIGIBILITY TEST WEDNESDAY 11 NOVEMBER 2020

You will have received an email giving your child's designated test centre, candidate number and an entrance to report to on arrival. **Please print the email and provide your child with a copy to bring to the exam. This is needed on arrival.**

- **All candidates must wear a face covering**

WHAT TO DO ON ARRIVAL:

Please make your way to your designated arrival gate as advised on your email.

ARRIVAL TIME

Arrive between 2.00-2.10pm No earlier than 2.00pm
Testing will start at 2.30pm

We will have staff on hand to receive your child at each entrance and take them to their allocated seat in the school, so there should be minimal need for queueing on arrival. Should you have to wait for your child to be collected from you, please ensure that you observe social distancing. Candidates must wear a face covering upon arrival.

TRAVEL TO GREENSHAW HIGH SCHOOL

Please ensure that you read the information on the website about travel to Greenshaw High School. There will be no parking on or near the site. Please note that there are new road closures and parking restrictions around the school. Please go to our school website for further information.

When waiting at your designated collection point, please form an orderly, socially distanced line. Candidates and parents/carers must wear face coverings. When the tests are complete, the candidates will be brought out by staff and walked along their line for you to claim.

Parents/carers need to leave promptly once their child has been collected and taken into the school.

Candidates must bring the following items with them:-

- A **printout** of the email giving their candidate number and arrival point (don't expect to show us the number on your phone). This is very important. If you don't have access to a printer you can write the candidate number, entrance point and seat number on a piece of paper.
- A face covering
- 2 or more HB or B pencils. We will not be lending equipment in order to maintain Covid safety
- A good quality rubber
- Hand sanitiser and tissues

- A jumper or fleece. Make sure that your child has enough warm layers as we will be keeping windows and doors open to ensure good ventilation. Please note that candidates will be queuing outside, even if it rains, so please ensure that they are dressed appropriately.

They may also bring:-

- A bottle of water – no fizzy drinks please – and a snack (no nuts).
- A ruler to help them keep their place on the answer sheet.
- A book to read before the tests start and during the break.

Your child should not bring a mobile telephone or any other electronic device, a calculator or calculator watch; any watch that beeps; any piece of stationery which displays times tables or other such information or a dictionary.

If you have decided that you do not wish your child to sit the Selective Eligibility Test after all, please will you email the school (admissions@greenshaw.co.uk) as soon as you receive your candidate number.
