Staggered start:

To support Year 7 as they adjust to secondary school, we will stagger the start of homework, beginning Monday 15th September. For the next four weeks, students will have just one homework to do each week, thus giving time to get used to each new homework type and iron out any issues, whether at home or at school. Digital access:

Consequently, students must be able to access the internet from home, using a tablet or chromebook/PC. **Please note: While homework may be viewed on a phone, it should not be used for completing homework.** If this is an issue, please contact the Head of Year for support.

Homework Catch-up:

If students fail to complete their homework in a given week, we will direct them to a catch-up session on Friday after school. This is compulsory and the goal is to find out what went wrong and prevent it repeating the next week. Initially, once the problem has been identified and resolved, students will be sent home but if the issues persist, students will be required to stay and complete the homework in the catch-up session before they are dismissed.
