

# Admissions

For Entry in September 2026

(for children born between 1 September 2014 and 31 August 2015 – current Year 6 at primary school)



# How are places allocated?

There are 314 places available in Year 7. Children with an EHCP will be allocated a place before any other applications are considered

1. Looked after children
2. Exceptional medical or social reason (additional form to complete which is available on our website)
3. 60 SET/ability places
4. Children of permanent staff
5. Siblings
6. Distance



# How are SET/ability places allocated?

If your child passes the SET, this means that you are **eligible to apply** for one of the 60 ability places. You will need to include Greenshaw as one of your preferences on your CAF

- Ability places are offered to the 60 highest scoring candidates, distance is **not** considered
- 3252 passed for Greenshaw High School for September 2025 entry
- 911 applied for 60 places in Year 7 for September 2025 entry
- Ability students are **not** taught in a different stream/band



# SET/ability Registration

- SET registration for entry in September 2026 is now closed. **SET registration for entry in September 2027 will open 1<sup>st</sup> May 2026**
- Registration for entry in September 2025 closed on 1st August 2025  
(13<sup>th</sup> June for SEN access arrangements)

# How do I apply?

- **All applications** including those for ability places, must be made via the Common Application Form (CAF) and sent to your local home authority
- Deadline for applications is **31 October 2025**
- If your child passed the SET, you do not need to complete an additional form. You will need to list Greenshaw as one of your preferences on your CAF
- **You do not need to sit the SET to apply for a place at Greenshaw High School**



# When will I receive the outcome?

National offer day is 2 March 2026

All local authorities will send outcomes to their own residents on 2 March

The offer letter will give instructions on how to accept or decline any place you have been offered



# Waiting lists

If the school is oversubscribed and has more applicants than places available, children who cannot be offered a place will be added to the waiting list providing they have not been offered one of their higher preference schools

You will be contacted if a place becomes available

Waiting lists are kept in the same order as the admissions criteria of the school

Waiting lists can change at any time and places may go up or down

Waiting lists remain open until the end of the autumn term 2026
