Homework Catchup:

If students fail to complete their homework in a given week, we will direct them to a catch up session on Friday after school. This is compulsory and the goal is to find out what went wrong and prevent it repeating the next week. Initially, once the problem has been identified and ironed out, students will be sent home but if the issues persist, students will be required to stay and complete the homework in the catchup session before they are dismissed.
