You will have received an email giving your child's designated test centre and candidate number. **Please print the email and provide your child with a copy to bring to the exam. This is needed on arrival.**

WHAT TO DO ON ARRIVAL:

Greenshaw High School	Please queue outside Gate 5 on Grennell Road.

Your child will have an allocated seat for the test and will be taken to that seat.

Your child should arrive at the school at 14:15. Testing will start at 14:30 and should be completed by 16.15. Please note the end time is approximate and we would welcome your patience on the day.

Parents are requested to leave promptly once they have delivered their children.

WHAT TO DO AT PICK-UP:

Greenshaw High School	Your child will return to Gate 5 and will be supervised until collection. Please arrive to collect your child at 16:15. Please be patient as the safety of candidates and staff is paramount. Please do not come to the main school entrance.

Please ensure that you read the information on the website about travel to Greenshaw High School. There will be no parking on site. You are strongly recommended to use public transport and please be aware that parking attendants will be operating in the area.

Candidates must bring the following items with them:-

- **A printout of the email giving their candidate number (don't expect to show us the number on your phone). This is very important.**
- **2 HB or B pencils**
- **A good quality rubber**

They may also bring:-

- **A bottle of water – no fizzy drinks please – and a snack (no nuts).**
- **A book to read during the break (this is optional and nothing to do with the exam).**
- **A jumper or fleece.**
- **A ruler to help them keep their place on the answer sheet.**

Your child should not bring a mobile telephone or any other electronic device, a calculator or calculator watch; any watch that beeps; any piece of stationery which displays times tables or other such information or a dictionary.

If you have decided that you do not wish your child to sit the Selective Eligibility Test after all, please will you email the Admissions Officer at the school (admissions@greenshaw.co.uk) as soon as you receive your candidate number.
